Treasure Lagoon

Laguna del Tesoro is accessed by boat from Boca de Guamá and through a canal surrounded by thick vegetation. With its 9 km² and 5 km diameter, trout abound in the lake, which inhabit its crystalline waters of 4 m in average depth. It is a perfect place for nature tourism and sport fishing in Cuba.

Legend has it that when the Indians believed themselves to be in danger by the Spanish conquerors, they sank a boat in the lake with their most precious possessions to prevent the theft of their wealth.

In addition to trout, you can find manatees and manjuarías, a fish that is considered a living fossil that is only found in the Zapata swamp, although its fishing is prohibited.

At the eastern limit of the Montemar Park, the Treasure Lagoon is
